- The product is not washable. Please ensure that it is used within a valid time period.

Store in a dry, ventilated place away from open flames and combustible materials.

Change the mask if it is wet, short of breath, dirty or after 8 hours of use.

USER GUIDE:

How to place the foam for extra comfort

Peel off the protective layer of the foam and stick it, following the nose clip lines, centered at the interior of the mask.

How to put on a face mask (Version L)

- Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer before touching the mask.
- 2. Remove a mask from its packaging, making sure that the mask does not have any obvious cracks, holes, or damage.
- 3. The side of the mask with a flexible and rigid edge faces up.
- 4. Elastic ear loop mask: Hold the mask by the loops. Pull the loops behind your ears.
- 5. Pull the lower part of the mask down so that it covers your mouth and chin.
- 6. Shape the mask's nose clip to match the shape of the nose for the best possible seal.





USER GUIDE:

How to put on a face mask (Version - T)

- 1. Hold the respirator in place with one hand and spread the edges to fully open it with the other hand. Bend the nose clip on top of the respirator to form a slight curve.
- 2. Turn the respirator over to expose the two headbands, then spread them apart with your thumb and forefinger. Hold the headbands with your index finger and thumb and the respirator under your chin.

Place the top of the headband on the crown of your head, over your ears, not under them. Place the lower strap on the back of your head under your ears.

- 4. Make sure the respirator is flat against your cheeks.
- 5. Form the nosepiece over the bridge of your nose, then press well with your fingers until you have a good face fit. If you can't get a good fit, don't go ahead.



How to remove a mask

- 1. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer before touching the mask. Do not touch the front mask. The face of the mask is contaminated. Only touch the clips / tapes. Follow the instructions below for the type of mask you are using.
- 2. Ear strap mask: Hold both ear straps and carefully lift and remove the mask.
 Dispose of the mask in a waste container according to your waste procedures. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer.
- 3. Tie-on mask: Hold both ties and carefully lift and remove the mask.
 Dispose of the mask in a waste container according to your waste procedures. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer.



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
